About the Artist:

Lola is a Salem educator who loves to integrate art into every part of her life. She received her Master's in *Art Therapy* from *Marylhurst* after teaching pre-K through university for more than thirty-eight years. She is particularly interested in multicultural projects that allow one to see through the eyes of other people. She believes art is life.

Objectives:

- To integrate the psyche of the mature individual with the innocence of childhood, creating a firmer attachment for the child and an opportunity for the senior to relieve tension, boredom, and listlessness

Activities:

- Ten hourly activities designed to allow senior and child to work together to create art

Workshop Size Limits:

- Six seniors + twelve children maximum (ratio preferred 1:1)

Special Equipment:

- Tempura paints (8 colors), paper, scissors, cardboard, shaving cream, popsicle sticks, yarn, variety of colored paper, magazines, short, chubby pencils, crayons, markers, metallic papers of various shapes and colors

Space Needed:

One classroom with table large enough for number of people registered
