- Résumé demonstrating your experiences as an artist and/or as a teaching artist
- One-page outline of a ten-session curriculum
- One current lesson plan that references the Oregon State Standards
- Examples of your own recent work
- Two professional references
- Availability for teaching and travel within Marion, Polk and Yamhill counties
