## Kids' Court Application Information

The Salem Art Association is accepting applications for Salem Art Fair & Festival Kids' Court. The Kids' Court Area was created to provide educational groups with an opportunity to promote themselves and their programs. Due to the limited number of spaces available, organizations will be selected whose purpose is the support or promotion of the arts, environment and education.

SAA encourages creative usage of your space and always welcomes new ideas to maintain the Kids' Court vitality. If you are a past participant, please consider a new activity or "sprucing" up your previous activity.

Each group/organization will decide the number of tickets needed to participate in their particular booth's activity (usually between 1-3 tickets). Tickets will be a \$1.00 each and will be sold at the Ticket Booth located directly in the middle of the Kids' Court. The booth will be staffed with SAA representatives. Each group/organization will be responsible for counting their tickets each evening, and for turning-in a final Sales Report which will be furnished by SAA. Groups/organizations will receive 100% of their ticket revenue. This is Salem Art Association's way of paying it forward into the community. Having a booth in Kids' Court is a great way to fundraise for your particular group/organization. Engaging, educational and rewarding activities are recommended to efficiently promote your group/organization to the community.

### Kids' Court Guidelines:

1. The Salem Art Association will provide tents, tables and chairs for a fee.
2. If accepted, the group's space will be assigned in Kids' Court by SAA.
3. Booths must be staffed during **all** Kids' Court hours:  
Friday - Saturday from 10 am to 6 pm and Sunday from 10 am to 5 pm
4. Activities must be accepted by SAA and adhere to all safety and environmental standards.
5. Organizations must furnish their own booth signs including an 11 x 17 foam core sign showing the activity, materials & ticket price. These will be hung in the Kids' Court Ticket Booth.
