Sir: You will perceive by the proceedings of yesterday which I send you that I failed to get an amendment adopted to pay the expense of the extra session of the Legislative Assembly held in 1850. No request had ever come from Oregon to have the matter provided for, nor any thing sent on showing what the expense was.
