If you think it not of sufficient importance to publish it entire, why just publish the notice of the times and places of speaking, and let it go at that.

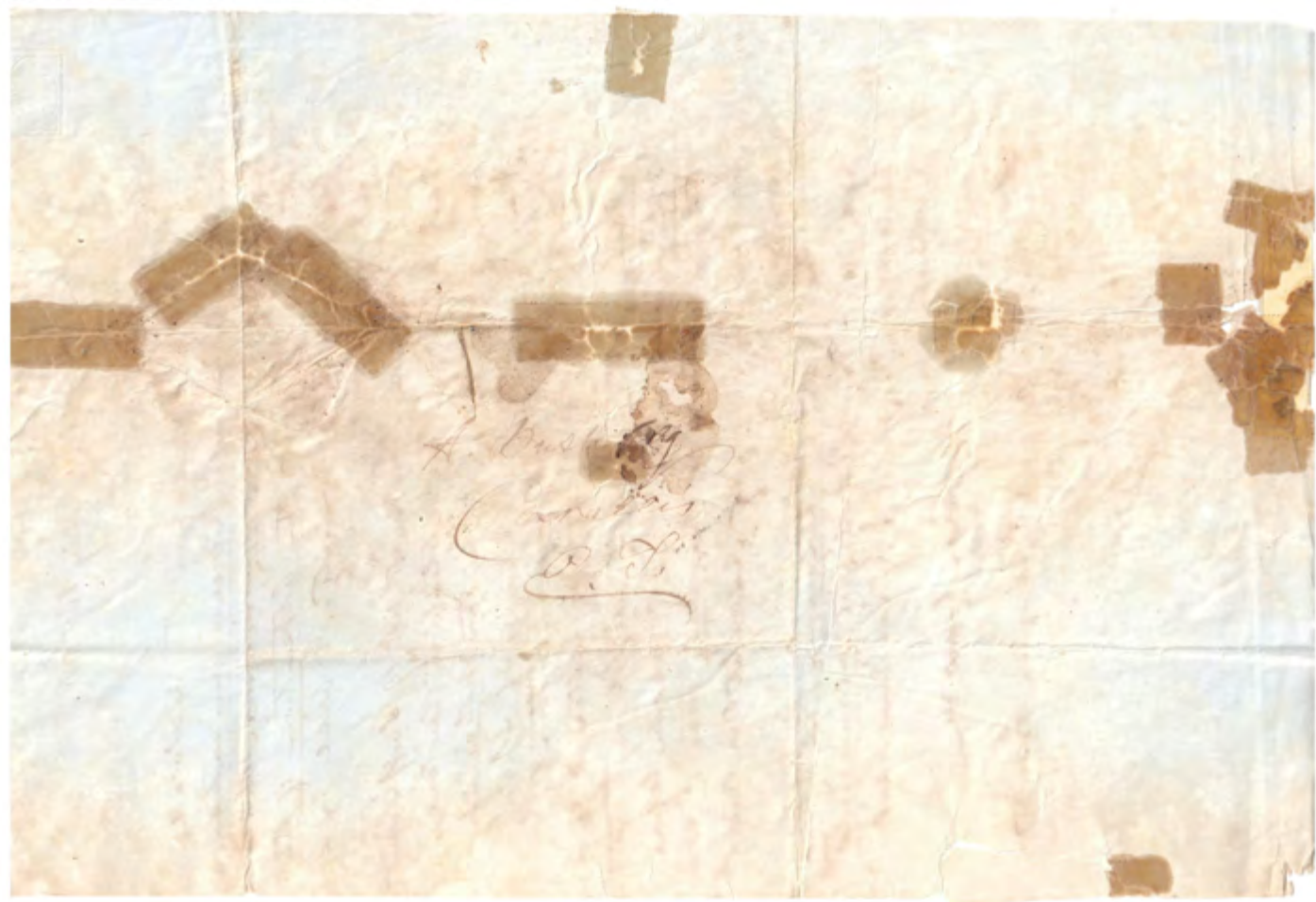
I thought it better to explain, otherwise I might be thought officious. The last week before the election is the only time I can be in this county, except our court week.
