Dear Bush

Before I left home I got your letter declining to come south. Just as I expected. You have lost an interesting trip and I am sorry you did not come out. Your friend Capt. Walker as usual when about to be in your way died. He was gathered to his fathers a few days since. The printing business is I think all right in this county. John Miller is worth any dosen men in the county. Old was acquitted after a trial of six days. Farrar made a good effort for the defence. I and Farrar start for Yreka in a few moments. I will write you at length when I get home in about ten days.
