Dear Bush

Before sending this to the office, I will add the latest news south of the Canyon. Word was received at Deer Creek yesterday that the retreat of the Indians had been discovered and preparations were making to attack them. They have been discovered by spies. It appears they are fortified on a body of table land containing 4 or 500 acres on the top of a mountain about ten ten miles east of the Grave Creek house. They have plenty of water, horses mules & provisions, and are keen for fight. Major Fitzgerald has sent to Fort Lane for a mountain Howitzer. Their number has been estimated by the scouts at 300, but it is quite likely that the number is exaggerated. The volunteers have left Deer Creek for the scene of action. Bill Martin has been elected major. Dr Drew has gone with him in some sort of character, compounded of the soldier and "pen writing". You know the new Major is not very expert in the use of the last mentioned weapons. I expect he will keep you posted with a running history of the movements of the army.
