

Portland May 17 1859

Dear Bush

I send you today 4 prs of blinds 10 x 16 but the 2 prs 9 x 14 are not to be had, that is not a regular size those sash must have been made by some gentleman from "Indiana" they were x9 x 13 next size 10 x 14 those will have to be made and you can probably get those sash and blind makers to make them as cheap there as anywhere-----

I saw Nat---he was slightly inebriated at the time---he spoke of you as a man did of his wife when he "With all her faults he lover her still"---Mrs. Lane told me that notwithstanding all you had said---and mean as you had behaved--they could not make Nat say one word against you----
