Dear Bush

What are we to do in regard to the Lane Society Convention at Eugene on the 17th prox? Shall we ignore it entirely, as also the election of a Congressman in June or shall we attempt to control it,- something I fear we cannot successfully undertake - or shall we salt a Douglass, non-intervention dem. Con. and nominate our own man?

The damned fool republicans have called a convention for the 19th of Apr. I hoped they would keep still and, if they saw fit in June to vote for a Congressman, they would vote at least for some independent candidate - possibly a Douglass democrat.

They are a damned impracticable, brainless set of asses to attempt to push out a man on a republican plat. from just at this time.

In Umpqua, Coos and Curry we can yet do any thing that is desired and; if the views of my friends are not plainly indicated in the premises through the columns of your very valuable paper (with which I am quite as much delighted, as are Delasons correspondents with his masheen), I would take it as a great favor to have a private note from you in regard to the action proposed to be taken relative to the coming of June election &c.

Saw Deady as he passed by - he does not like your publication of extracts from his old letters - deems it to have been highly injurious and unnecessary &c &c. He does not profess to be a very strong Joseph man now. I can't find out just where he is. Did not see Nes. but believe he got encouragement from Douglas Co.

Dan. Stewart writes me that, if the republicans make no nomination in Douglass, we shall be beat. By we, he means I suppose the regular ticket in that County, which will be thoroughly Lane Society of course.

Dan. is the person referred to by your Lane Co. Correspondent of last week, who speaks of a Douglass Co. man who was strong for Lane but anti-Delason Reason, had been promised an Ind. Agency.

I think an independent ticket for the Legislation can be carried in Douglas Co. - intend to go up there soon.

Regards to all my Salem friends, especially those at Judge Brice's and your house. I hear Beggs has a daughter - Congratulations.
