Friend Bush-

I have just received your letter, as the mail will close soon I will not have time to write much. I am sorry you have been to the trouble of getting Money for McLoughlin-& he not to take it. I have collected Money enough to let him have what he wanted if I was there to let him have it.

I have sent you, By William Bybee, one of the delegates to the Eugene convention \$310.00 to pay you the \$300.00 note you hold against me. Sind the Note to me at Roseburg, and write me the amount of interest due on it when Bybee Pays you the money.-& if the \$10.00 I sent you is not enough to pay it I will pay you the remainder when I go to Salem.

O'Meara & the rest of the Delgates to Eugene will start below in a day or two. I beleve he & Fanny Davidson will be M-----d before he returns, as he has rented a Dwelling House. Where Mrs. Harris used to live.

Josephine County will go for judge Williams & judge Deady or Nesmith Lane & Smith can not get that county. I saw William I Allan a day or two ago: he seem to be well posted in the Politics of that county.-he said A. Lane & Smith man could not be elected in that county.

I H Reed, & O'Meara dos not like to see "The Times" of Portland raise the Name of Stout for Congress again Reed is quite Pale over it
