Dear Bush

Your favor came duly to hand D A Brown has not ponied yet---Nor Hall---have recieved no. money from Privitt "et al" at the Dalls.---find there is nothing in that property of Stark's except one note in favor of Kamm for \$2500 drawing 20% but Stark is paying by verbal agreement 2% per month---since the 1st of Jany 60---the note was drawin in '57---nothing of interest transpiring here---by the way Charlie Stewart wanted "St Pierre" to question the enterprise he has manifested in bringing to this country the class of performers he has of late been exhibiting---the Theatre has been pretty fair for this country you can gather more detailed report the drama from the dailies-----
