

New York City July 20th 1860

Friend Bush

Enclosed you will find a few pages of my scribbling, that you can use in the shape of a letter, if you wish to. --- I came here yesterday from the northern part of this state, and evrywhere I have been - The Democrats are for Douglas, 3 to 1, for Breckenridge. Douglas could have almost carried this State was it not for the Fedral appointees who are exerting all their influence- to Defeat him and set up a Hurrah for Breckenridge & Lane. I was at the Cooper Institute last night & here Daniel S Dickesson speak. The Hall was filled. -- about one half was for Douglas. . When ever the crowd cheerd Breckenridge & Lane, or Dickinson, the Douglas men would cheer Douglas. Although the meeting was for to ratify "the Leander Candidates." there was as maney in faver of Douglas---. Dickinson spent most of the time in abusing the New York Delegation, to the Baltimore Convention for not supporting himself, in place of Douglas -- He is a good speaker. Enclosed you will find his speech--after him, their was a soft Head, who bosted of being with Lane in Mexico--spoke until some of the crowd began to leve--He spoke about as Delazan dos when he Puffs himself & Lane --

I am afraid the the Lane men will invent some plan to defeat Nesmith, in the Senate. But the opposition are in power- & ought to elect him-with some one else-

By this mornings papers I see that Douglas had a fine reception at Hartford- as well as at Boston.---

There would not had been half the turn out last night at the Cooper Institute but for the expectation of seeing Benjamin Stevens, Cushing & O'Connor, & Butler, none of them was there, that was the Plan the Boston House officers took to get a crowd to make some noise for Breckenridge.

I tell all who speake to me about Lane popularity in Oregon- that he will be beat there next fall- I have seen something like that in the two of the Daly Papers here-
