VACCINATION AND MASK POLICY FOR IN-PERSON WORKSHOPS & SUMMER CAMPS *(Last Updated March 1, 2022)*

In accordance with public health guidelines and best practices, including those issued by the Oregon Department of Education, SAA will require:

- all instructors to be fully vaccinated (including boosters) prior to teaching in our workshops and summer camps, and
- all participants - including both adults and children - to be fully vaccinated (including boosters) in order to take part as learners in our workshops and summer camps.

To ensure full compliance, we will require proof of vaccination prior to the first day of enrollment.

When participating in workshops and summer camps, all instructors and students will be required to wear masks while indoors.

In addition, we also ask all instructors and participants to perform a self-evaluation before coming to SAA and to stay home if they feel sick or have Covid-like symptoms.

SAA will provide hand sanitizing stations and will regularly clean high-touch surfaces. We will also provide N95 and/or KN95 masks for all participants as needed (pending the availability of supplies).

By requiring vaccination and continuing to practice other virus prevention measures, we can best provide the quality of instruction, group learning, and joyful togetherness that are at the heart of the SAA experience.
