Salem Salon is a non-juried art exhibition open to both emerging and established artists in Salem and neighboring communities.

The exhibition dates are June 30 - July 30, 2023. The opening reception is on Saturday, July 1, 2023 from 4 -7 p.m.

We invite regional artists working in all mediums to apply. SAA is committed to equity and inclusion, and we welcome and encourage people of all races, ethnicities, abilities, and gender identities to apply.

This is a non-juried show and submissions should be dropped off on Saturday, June 24 and Sunday, June 25, 2023, from Noon to 5 p.m. at the Bush Barn Art Center & Annex, 600 Mission St. SE, Salem.

Only one work may be submitted as space this year is limited. The work will be hung in Salon Style and we will accept work until the space is full. There is no submission fee for this show.

SALEM SALON ENTRY FORM

SUBMISSION AND PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- 2D work should be no larger than 36" x 36", wired and ready to hang.
- 3D work should not exceed 36" in any direction and should weigh less than 30 lbs.
- Work should be clearly labeled on the back with the artist's First and Last name, title of the work, size of the work and, if for sale, the selling price. SAA takes a 50% commission on all sales.
- Any framing must be clean and free of debris. Matting should be properly cut to professional standards.
- Hanging wire and Plexiglas are recommended. SAA will not be liable for any damage to artwork framed with glass. Unframed gallery wrapped canvases are acceptable for display. No wet paint, visible staples or recently varnished work.
- Textile wall hangings must have sleeves or tabs for hanging from a rod; a rod of adequate diameter and quality must accompany your work. Textile wall hangings without tabs or sleeves must be accompanied by a quilt hanger.
- Video / film entries must be accompanied with necessary equipment for display.
